## **Ft. Saskatchewan RCMP Requesting Public Assistance**

On July 8th 2011, Fort Saskatchewan RCMP responded to a theft complaint from Howe's Contracting and AGTL Construction.

The RCMP described the suspect as a tall medium build Caucasian male with short hair, tattoo on left shoulder, wearing overalls, a baseball cap and gloves. The male was driving a dark colour Ford, pickup truck, 4 doors. No licence plate was obtained.

It appears that a male drove through the W4 industrial area and entered several compounds. Keys from a "skidster" were stolen from Howe's Contracting. The same male attended AGTL construction and hot wired a truck, hooked it up to a trailer and appeared to be getting ready to steal a "skidster" from the location. For no apparent reason, the male left the scene and did not take the "skidster" with him.

The RCMP note that tips received from the general public have been very helpful in some of their ongoing investigations and have contributed much to recent successes. As such, they would like to encourage members of the general public to continue to report activity that they deem to be suspicious or of concern.
