Rocky View County Council signs servicing agreement with CN

Rocky View County, Alberta – At their regular meeting on July 26, 2011, Rocky View County Council authorized signing the CN agreement to have the water servicing infrastructure constructed for the Calgary Logistics Park at Conrich.

To enable CN's 680 acre Logistics Park to move forward with construction in Conrich, Council has authorized signing an agreement with CN to provide service for the supply and distribution of potable water to the Conrich area, including the CN lands.

Claude Mongeau, President and Chief Executive Officer of CN, says, "CN is pleased that Rocky View Council has approved the servicing and infrastructure agreement. We are eager to break ground for the new logistics park, which will help provide seamless transportation solutions to rail customers moving products and commodities into and out of Calgary, one of the fastest growing cities in North America and a key logistics hub for consumer and industrial goods markets in Alberta."

CN announced plans to establish a new \$200 million dollar Logistics Park located in Rocky View County at Conrich, including a multi commodity transload and warehouse facility; automotive compound; liquid/bulk transload and distribution facility. The park will offer the potential of a warehousing area of over two million square feet to customers who need to distribute their goods. The site is conveniently located a few miles east of the Calgary International Airport and is accessible to major roadways.

"To have a project of this scale in Rocky View County is outstanding," says Reeve Rolly Ashdown. "We are excited about the new opportunities this will open up for the County."

CN has agreed to fund the water service initially, to be paid back by potential users over time as development occurs.
