

Rocky View County Fire Service crews respond to acreage fire

Rocky View County, Alberta – At approximately 4:27 am Rocky View County Fire Service (RVCFS) crews responded to a two-storey single family house fire on Range Road #275, approximately five kilometres south off Highway #1 between Chestermere and Langdon.

Upon arrival, the house was fully involved in fire. Crews began an immediate fire attack. Two adults and two children had already exited the fully involved house when fire crews arrived. They were transported by Alberta Health Services to a Calgary hospital and are listed in stable condition. One child remains unaccounted for. Six RVCFS apparatus and 19 fire fighters responded to the fire.

ATCO remain on scene to manage utilities. RCMP and RVCFS crews remain on scene to monitor hot spots and overhaul the site. Cause of the fire is currently under investigation and there are no damage estimates at this time.

Further information will be released as the investigation continues.
